Rolling Back the 30x30 and Natural Assets

On day one of President Trump's administration, he rescinded the Biden Executive Orders that initiated the 30x30 and Natural Asset agendas. This was a great start to restoring property rights in America.

While the policies have been rescinded, the programs entrenched by the Biden administration must now be dug out and stopped. Some will require Congress's action and others will require Presidential or Departmental Orders.

Here are 20 key provisions that must be rolled back to protect American's property rights :

- REVOKE BIDEN'S 30X30 LAND GRAB POLICY
- Rescind Section 216 of Executive Order 14008 entitled Tackling the Climate Crisis at Home and Abroad (86 Fed. Reg. 7,619) directing federal agencies to "conserve at least 30 percent of America's land and oceans by 2030."
- Day 1 Remove the "American the Beautiful" (a.k.a 30x30) agenda from all federal websites.
- 2. Rescind Funds Implementing 30x30 Programs
- Stop unspent Inflation Reduction Act funds for the climate smart conservation programs at USDA.
 - End \$1 Billion Commitment to the National Fish and Wildlife Foundation to implement the 30x30 agenda in America.

End the pilot test accounts, including the "land pilot test account," where the Biden Administration was preparing to add private property to the federal balance sheet as a U.S. Asset.

13. PERMANENTLY STOP NATURAL ASSET COMPANIES

Pass the "Protect the American Lands Act," that amends the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 to prohibit exchanges from effecting transactions in securities issued by natural-asset companies or similar vehicles.

 - Prohibit all federal agencies for using the United Nations' System of Environmental Economic Accounting (UN-SEEA) to establish the value of wwecosystem and environmental services.

Rescind the USDA Sustainability Targets in Agriculture to Incentivize Natural Solutions (SUSTAINS) Act of 2021. This allows the federal government to both monetize natural processes, and determine who owns those processes on private lands without the landowners consent.

ISSUE RULES FOR THE SUSTAINS ACT THAT PROTECT LANDOWNERS Notice to landowners that discloses enrollment in the program will allow an outside entity or the federal government to own and profit from the "ecosystem services" on their property; Landowner must consent to an outside entity or the federal government owning "ecosystem services" on their land; and The program cannot be applied retroactively on private lands already enrolled in the climate smart conservation programs.

17. END FUNDING FOR NEW FEDERAL LAND ACQUISITIONS

Prohibit funds for programs used to purchase private property from increasing federal ownership of lands, unless the acquisition facilitates a land wswap resulting in no net gain of federal lands.



- 18. REDUCE FEDERAL LAND INVENTORY
- Identify federal lands that would be better purposed if returned to the private sector, excluding those protected by Congress such as national parks and wildlife refuges.
- 19. SUNSET AND PHASE OUT CONSERVATION EASEMENTS
- Sunset conservation easements to 15 years or less
- End new federal enrollments
- Develop a phase-out program for existing federally held and funded easements to be extinguished after 30 years
- Tax Land Trusts for the value of the conservation easements they hold in perpetuity.
- 20. REDUCE REGULATORY EXPENSE ON PRIVATE LANDS
 - Exempt private lands from federal land use regulations if there are no federal funds, programs, or approvals attached to the land.
